A Memorandum of Understanding between

**Islamic University - Kenya,
and Islamic Psychology College- Turkey.**

Praise be to Allah, and peace and blessings be upon our prophet Muhammad, and upon all his family and companions, and thereafter;

On the 29 day of Gumada Alawal 1446 corresponding to Monday the second of December 2024, an agreement was reached between:

The Islamic University - Kenya, headquartered at

Kisaju Along the Nairobi Namanga Highway represented in this agreement by **His Excellency Professor Mohamed Osman**, the Founder and Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the University, or his delegate, referred to in this agreement as the First Party.

Islamic Psychology College- Turkey, headquartered at

Beylikdüzü, Cumhuriyet Barbaros hayrettin paşa 1988 no 4/193, Esenyurt/İstanbul Türkiye
Represented in this agreement by **His Excellency Professor Mohamed Mahmoud Moustafa**, founder and dean of the college, or his delegate.

Preamble:

Whereas the Islamic University seeks to offer internationally recognized academic programs, and the Islamic Psychology College seeks to enhance the standards of education and academic research, and based on the mutual desire between the two parties, and affirming the great importance of the principle of academic and intellectual cooperation, contributing to human, cultural, and knowledge development, and in the interest of building bridges of civilizational communication and achieving mutual benefit in the field of human sciences, especially Islamic psychology, it has been agreed to conclude this agreement to enhance academic cooperation and exchange expertise, curricula, professors, and competencies, according to the rules and regulations in force at the university, and it states the following:

Article 1:

The preamble is considered part of this agreement.

Article 2:

This agreement aims to:

1. The First Party accredits the certificates and academic and training programs issued by the Second Party according to the rules in force at the university.
2. Enhancing cooperation in scientific research and academic projects.
3. Exchange of faculty members and students between the two parties.
4. Acceptance of graduates from both sides to complete postgraduate studies in accordance with the rules.

Article 3:

The First Party is committed to the following:

- Accrediting the Second Party as one of its colleges and recognizing the graduates' certificates in accordance with the regulations in effect in the country of origin.
- Granting students who have completed the graduation requirements from the various programs of the Islamic Psychology College the scientific certificates in the name of the Islamic University in Kenya, as well as graduation certificates and transcripts in both Arabic and English, authenticated by the Islamic University and the Ministry of Higher Education in Kenya.
- Accepting graduate students from both parties to complete studies at various levels and programs.
- The First Party commits to mentioning the Second Party in all official papers, student certificates, periodic advertisements, and promotional materials, and adding the website in the First Party's records and official social media.

Article 4:

The Second Party is committed to the following:

- Stating that the First Party is the entity authorized to accredit certificates and programs issued by the Second Party.
- Providing the First Party with the educational system of the Second Party and working on modifying it to conform to the systems of the First Party, while adhering to the performance standards in force at Kenyan universities.
- Adhering to the admission standards for student registration according to the conditions in force in Kenyan university institutions.
- Registering the data of the students enrolled with the Second Party each semester with the First Party, including the required official documents in accordance with the laws and regulations in force at the Islamic University of Kenya.
- Teaching courses in the agreed programs in both Arabic and English.
- The Second Party is committed to paying the necessary expenses, tuition fees, and wages related to the educational services provided by the First Party as specified in the annex.
- Accepting students wishing to enroll in the programs of the Islamic Psychology College by the First Party, and those wishing to complete postgraduate studies.
- Exchanging academic and training programs between the two parties.
- Organizing joint workshops and conferences to enhance knowledge and experience.
- Encouraging joint research in the fields of Islamic psychology and related humanities.
- The Second Party participates in some specialized training programs for community service carried out by the First Party.

Article 5:

- Both parties are committed to maintaining confidentiality regarding data and information.
- Each party has the right to terminate the agreement, when necessary, with prior notification to the other party of the reasons for the decision.
- This document is considered a legal framework that governs the official academic relationship between the university and the college, and enhances the value of education in the field of Islamic psychology.
